Job Summary

Serving the Districts of Nipissing, Temiskaming and Muskoka, the Service of Child & Adolescent Psychiatry is seeking a Psychiatrist to join its team to provide inpatient and outreach intervention to youth with severe mental illness. Working to full scope of practice, the incumbent will apply clinical leadership and expertise in the assessment, treatment, and/or consultation for in-patient and community-based care, with some flexibility depending on professional interests.

Our inpatient service includes a 6-bed child & adolescent psychiatry unit operating in a collaborative care model in partnership with pediatricians who act as MRP. The unit serves children and adolescents under the age of 18 with severe mental illness who require acute short term stabilization and/or longer term treatment. The interdisciplinary team works collaboratively with community partners to facilitate a continuum of service provision with a goal to optimize inpatient treatment and promote mental health and recovery.

Our outreach service provides specialized mental health services and education for youth and their care providers. This includes comprehensive assessment, intervention and support to assist individuals with mental health disorders to remain in the community and to prevent hospitalization where possible.

NBRHC is also the North East lead for the Regional Children's Mental Health program which provides specialized consultations, inter-sectoral capacity building and knowledge exchange, inpatient service standardization, and centralized planning.

In addition, there are opportunities to join the faculty of NOSM and engage in clinical teaching at the undergraduate and postgraduate level.

Qualifications

Applicants are required to be certified in Psychiatry by the Royal College of Physicians and Surgeons of Canada (or the equivalent in another jurisdiction) and must be licensed (or eligible for licensure) in the Province of Ontario. Certification in the subspecialty of child & adolescent psychiatry would be a valuable added qualification for this position.

Remuneration

This position will be remunerated with a combination of clinical sessional fess, OHIP billings & Hospital On-Call Stipend.

Our organization does have a competitive Incentive Package which includes signing bonuses, assistance with moving expenses and up to \$80 000 through the Northern Rural Recruitment & Retention Initiative (NRRRI).
